Artist Application

Come exhibit at the 12th Annual Great Salt Lake Bird Festival. This Festival draws people of all ages who have an interest in birds and nature. The Festival is advertised in national birding magazines, birding clubs and organizations, in Utah's surrounding states, and on the West Coast. Visitors to previous Festivals have come from all across the nation.

Acceptable Categories

Ceramics: All original clay work. No commercial molds or machine or mass produced work.

Digital Art: 2-D works utilizing computer technology to create and/or manipulate visual images. All work must be signed and numbered as a limited edition.

Drawing: Crayon, charcoal, pencil, ink, chalk, pastel.

Glass: No commercial molds or other forms of mass production allowed.

Jewelry: No commercial casts, molds, or production studio work.

Metalwork: Non-sculptural metal work.

Painting: Oil, acrylics, watercolor, alkyd, pastel, tempera, other.

Photography: Prints made from artist's original negative; must be signed and numbered.

Printmaking: Any method used to pull an image from a surface (stone, block, plate, screen, etc.) prepared by the artist and signed and numbered.

Sculpture: Three-dimensional original work done in any medium will be considered.

Wearable Art: Leather, fiber, metal and all handmade wearable work. No mass production work will be accepted.

Wood: Original hand-tooled machine-worked, or carved work

2/3 Dimensional Mixed Media: Includes collage and hand-made paper and non-sculptural work.

How to Apply

To apply for the juried 2010 Great Salt Lake Bird Festival:

- 1) Complete the application form
- 2) Include \$10, non-refundable fee for each category applied for
- 3) Include three 35mm slides or photos of current work

This completed packet must be delivered to the historic Davis County Courthouse at 28 East State Room 221, Farmington, Utah by 5 pm on Monday, March 4, 2010.

Exhibitor Fees: Booth fee is \$45 each. All spaces are 10' x 10'. Exhibitors may request one or two booths. Booths may be indoors or outdoors. No commissions are taken by the Festival. Artists' booths must contain at original work.

Jury Selection: Jury selection will take place March 9th. Notification of acceptance or non-acceptance will be mailed March 11th.

Regulations



Exhibitors displaying work in a category other than the one for which they were accepted will be subject to removal from the festival.



Festival hours are Friday May 14 from 12 pm to 7pm and Saturday May 15 from 10 am to 6 pm



The Festival takes place rain, shine, or wind. Be prepared. Exhibitors display all work at their own risk. The Festival is not responsible for damage theft, or loss of an exhibitor's work.



The Festival provides one table and two chairs to each booth, if desired.



Great Salt Lake Bird Festival reserves the right to photograph and reproduce accepted artists artwork for educational and/or publicity purposes.



Indoor booths will be locked up Friday night. Outdoor booths will not. Exhibits must be taken down by Sunday, May 16th, by 2 pm.
